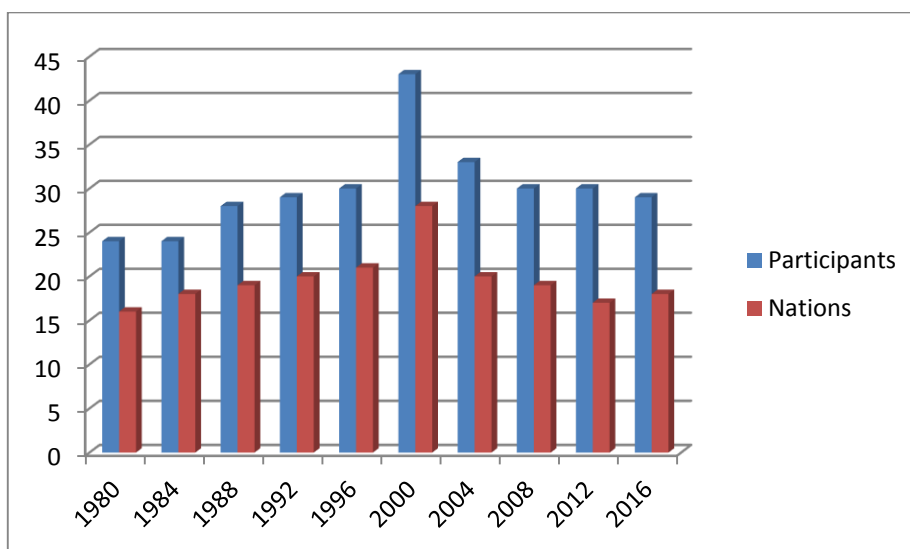

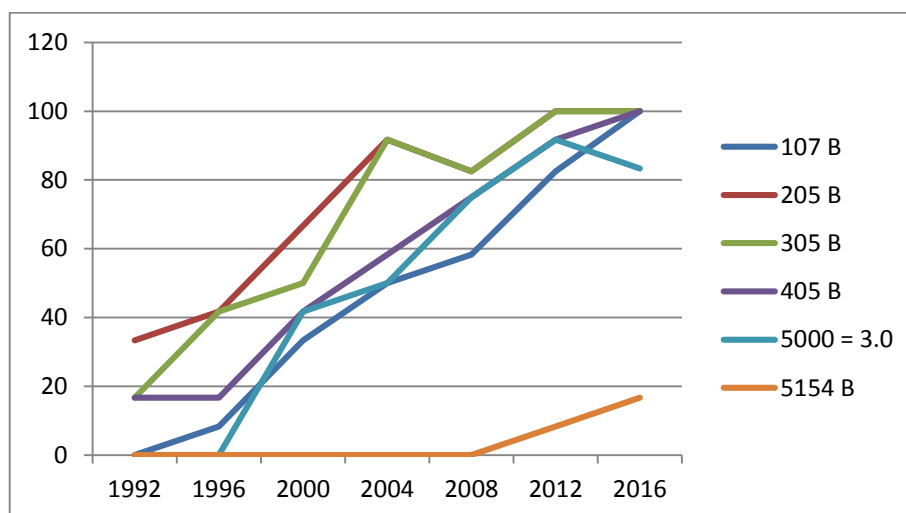

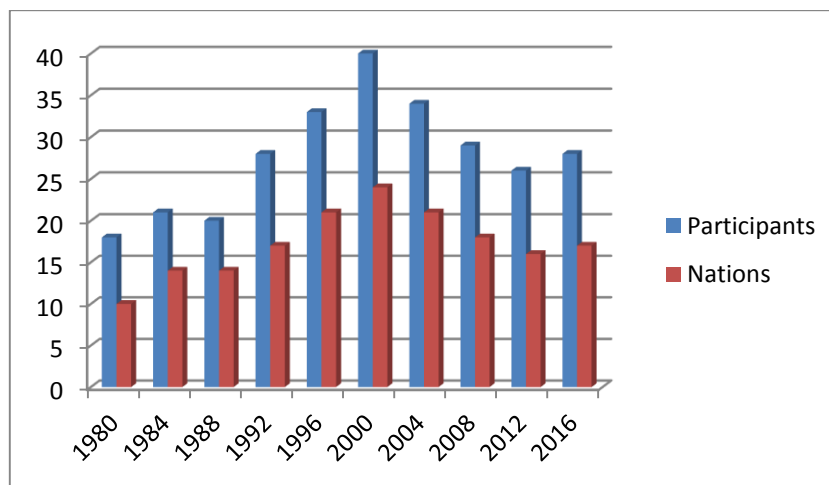

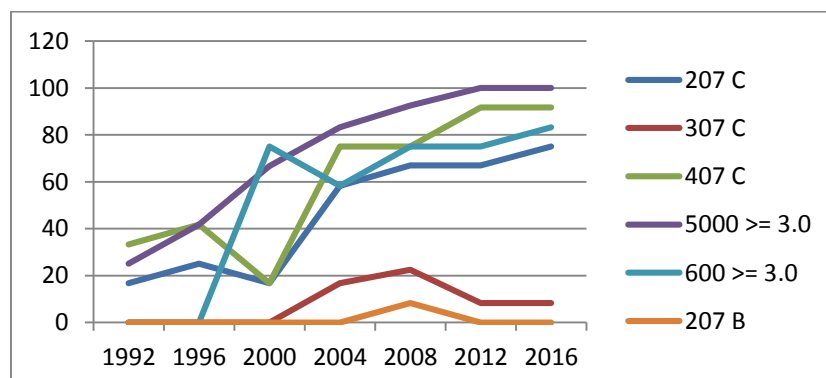

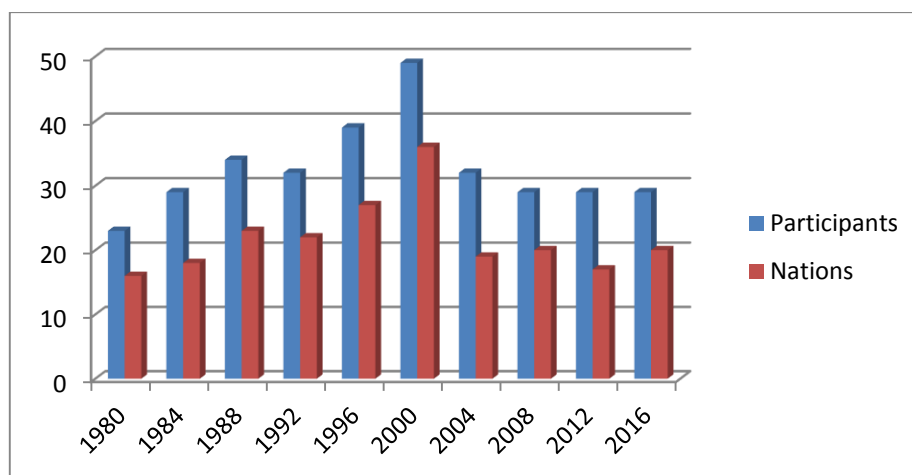

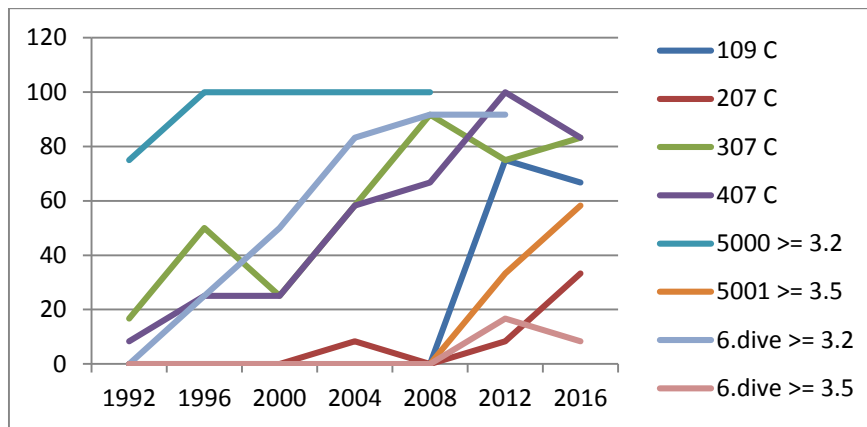

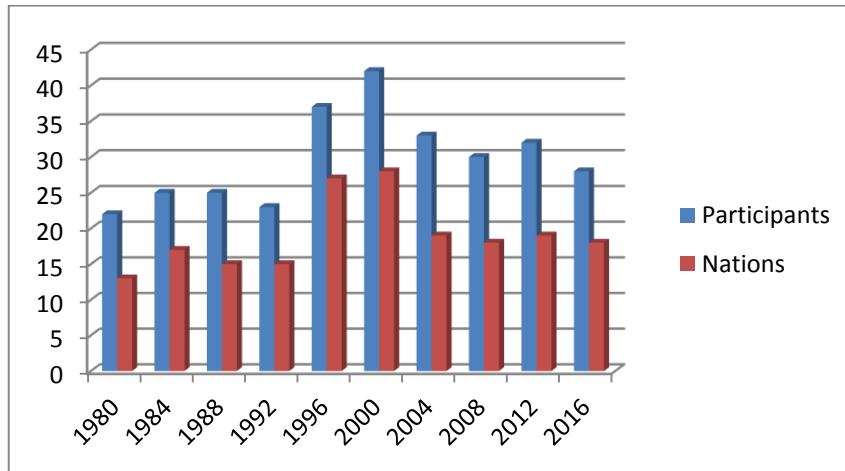

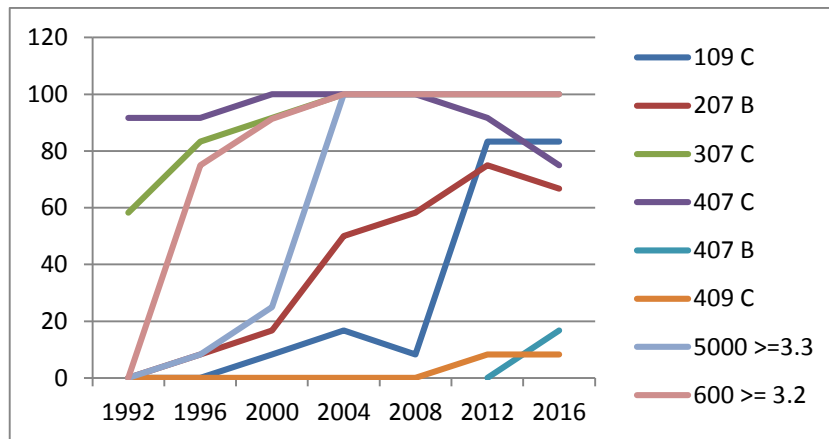

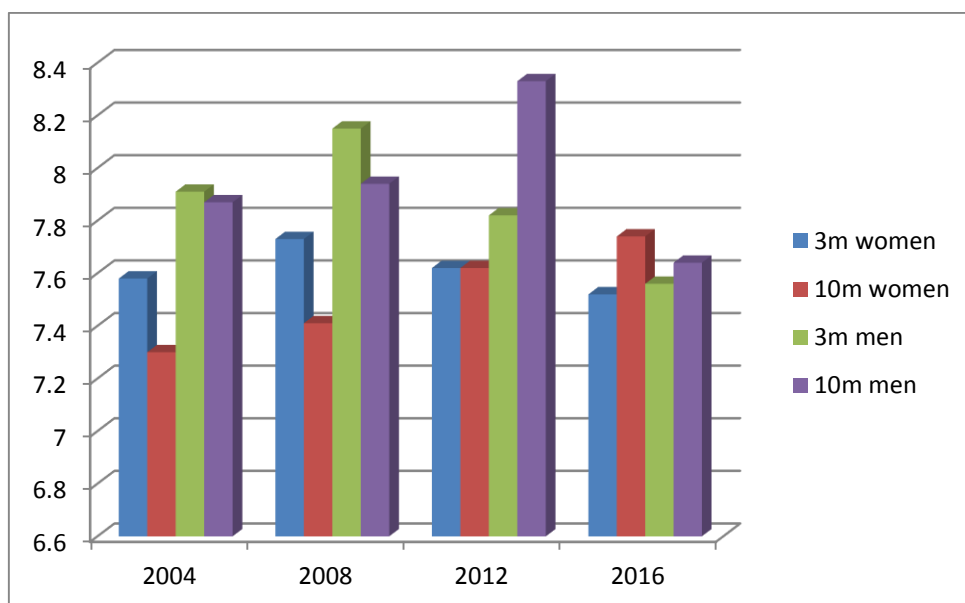
**Number of participants and participating nations**

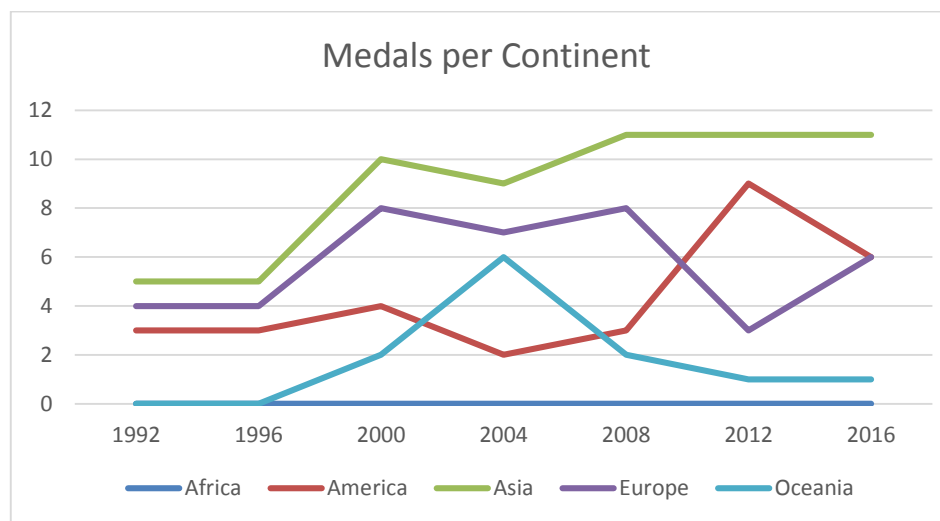
